
Tribute to Pierre Bellon (H.54)

HEC Talks: first conference of the year 2022 with Hubert Joly on "Purposeful Leadership"

After ECB President [Christine Lagarde](#), Nobel Prize-winning economist [Daniel Kahneman](#), and Buddhist monk and philosopher [Matthieu Ricard](#), HEC Talks was honored to welcome former Best Buy CEO Hubert Joly (H81) for its first edition of 2022. Now a senior lecturer at Harvard Business School, Hubert Joly is also particularly committed to the HEC community, especially since the creation in 2018 of the Joly Family Purposeful Leadership Chair, whose work around the quest for meaning in business inspires all the school's programs. Speaking to the hundred or so people present in the Blondefaud amphitheater and to a very large Internet audience, Hubert Joly revealed some of the secrets of his successes, explained in his best-seller published in 2021, [The Heart of Business: Leadership Principles for the Next Era of Capitalism](#) (the French version of which was released the same day as the conference). During his exchanges with HEC students, notably from the EMBA program, he was able to reaffirm his conviction: to place employees and the quest for meaning "at the heart of the company". FT ranking: HEC's MBA among the best in the world

HEC's performance in the FT's latest MBA 2022 ranking, published on February 14, is promising: in this highly competitive segment, our school is now ranked 11th worldwide, ex aequo with MIT Sloan, and continues to widen the gap with other business schools. In Europe, the HEC Paris MBA is ranked fourth. The global prominence of our 16-month MBA program is due not only to the excellence of our academic team, but also to all the teams who have worked tirelessly to improve the experience of our MBA students.
