HEC: No. 1 European Business School According to the FT

CMA CGM, HEC Paris and the HEC Foundation joined forces on December 21 in Beirut to create a scholarship program that will provide 20 Lebanese students per year with the opportunity to study at HEC Paris for ten years. The CMA CGM Excellence Fund for Lebanon will cover both tuition and living expenses for the beneficiaries: it will aim to train the Lebanese leaders of tomorrow, to help young Lebanese build a better future for themselves and to contribute to the reconstruction of their country. MBA January 2022 - a Historic Class

On January 6 and 7, the campus welcomed the new class of MBA students. This is a historic class in terms of its number. With 181 students, it is the largest January class ever. This is a consecration for this program whose reputation and recognition continue to grow throughout the world, as shown by the latest rankings, with a 7th place worldwide and 4th in Europe in [the latest Financial Times rankings](#).

It is also historic in the quality of the students with an average GMAT score of over 690 points and a particularly wide range of profiles: engineers, doctors, veterinarians, entrepreneurs, from all over the world... an embodiment of diversity and difference that create excellence. This year, 68 scholarships were awarded by the HEC Foundation thanks to the support of its donors.
