## Editorial by the White Paper on Biodiversity Team The HEC Community Makes a Stand for Biodiversity

Dear fellow alumni,

In June 2021, our President, Adrien Couret (H.07), decided that HEC Alumni should speak out on a number of important global and business issues. He mandated Christine Rodwell (H.92), a member of the Committee and Board, to form our team; we thank him warmly for the confidence he had in entrusting us with this mission which is both meaningful and responsible.

Why choose the theme of Biodiversity for this first White Paper? Biodiversity loss is emerging as a major business issue on which our community must take a position. Moreover, Sylvie Lemmet (H.81), French Ambassador for the Environment, wishes to understand and relay the recommendations of the private sector, experts and civil society to the negotiators at the COP 15 for the Convention on Biological Diversity.

Corporate activities are the principal cause of the sixth mass extinction. Businesses also suffer the consequences of the erosion of biodiversity upon which the production of raw materials, climate stability and disease regulation, among others, depend.

To address this issue, an intergenerational team of 7 alumni with different backgrounds and experiences, all passionate and convinced about the urgency of the biodiversity crisis, was formed.

Together, we conducted about 50 interviews with business leaders, investors, researchers, experts, and associations in order to better understand these issues and their implications. Our interlocutors confirmed the need to involve all of society's actors: the private sector, public authorities, citizens, NGOs and the academic world.

We have summarized their recommendations, our complementary research and the cross-fertilization of our experiences and expertise in a White Paper. This report begins by taking stock of biodiversity and its links with business activities, and then details the levers that need to be activated urgently to meet this challenge.

This work would not have been possible without the support of the Association and the commitment of the 7 members of our team. Our constant exchanges are at the heart of the success of this White Paper, which we hope will be the first of many.

Our work will be presented during a unique [event in French on June 7th](#), in the presence of Adrien Couret, Eloïc Peyrache, Sylvie Lemmet (H.81), Bruno David (president of the MNHN) and a number of interviewees.
