Dear friends,

In these times of extreme tension, let's celebrate the good news. We are happy to announce that **HEC Alumni has just finalized the purchase of an HEC House in London, a project that has mobilized our teams for the last 3 years.**

This moment is a high point for HEC Alumni and more broadly, for the entire HEC Paris ecosystem. First, it responds to the growing internationalisation of the HEC community (more than 50% of HEC students are not French). London hosts HEC's largest alumni community after Paris with **more than 3,000 graduates and over a hundred events organised each year**. HEC is very active there thanks to alumni events and actions designed by the School's representative office to **strengthen the power of the HEC brand** and galvanize our network: promotion of programs and the work of research professors, study trips, etc.

After a two-year search, HEC Alumni identified the ideal location to bring all HEC activities under the same roof. It is a superb **400 m² space in the "Hexagon" building, located close to Covent Garden**. After a phase of fit-out work to shape the premises to the needs of the HEC community, **the "HEC UK House" will open its doors in Autumn**. It will allow alumni clubs to organize their events, and the School to host its staff, hold masterclasses with professors, receive student study trips and conduct executive education programmes. The HEC Foundation will also be able to organize events for its donors. For alumni living in or visiting London, opportunities for meetings and co-working will be offered.

The HEC UK House real estate operation was negotiated over a long period of time and was led by the Committee which was given the power to carry out this acquisition by the General Meeting. **I would like to thank all those who contributed to this project, starting with my predecessor Frédéric Joussset (H.92)** who gave it a strong impetus, but also all those who worked on it within the Committee. I also thank the recent Deans of HEC Paris, Peter Todd and then Eloïc Peyrache, who saw this project as a way of giving the School a strong foothold in a city which attracts hundreds of our young graduates every year - Brexit did not change this. And of course, **the HEC Foundation which, thanks to the support of some early donors, has supported this project** and continues to offer everyone the opportunity to contribute.

Finally, it is the work of all of you, since no less than three General Meetings were necessary to validate different elements of this project.

Let us remember that almost 30 years ago, HEC graduates worked collectively to acquire the Association's premises on Avenue Franklin Roosevelt in Paris. Supported by Didier Pineau-Valencienne (H.54), the President of the Association at the time, and by hundreds of graduates who shared his vision, the purchase of our premises marked the start of the HEC network's accelerated development, contributing to making it one of the most powerful in the world. These premises now house the offices of the Association's permanent staff and allow the organization of almost 900 events per year.

I therefore invite you to take a moment to cheer the completion of this bold project in London, which will add a new cornerstone to HEC's international strategy and allow our network to reach its full potential outside France. **Let us celebrate this important and historic step for all HEC graduates!**

HEC Women in Leadership Club: An Inspiring Visit to Station F

On February 17, the members of the HEC Women in Leadership Club (WIL Club) visited Station F: a three-kilometer tour of the world's largest start-up campus, during which they were able to discover the HEC incubator and its 150 start-ups, meet many of the incubatees, and discuss women's entrepreneurship with Shaheena Janjuha-Jivraj, Associate Professor at HEC Paris in Qatar. WIL's new president, Tejal Pradhan (MBA.23), co-organized this visit as part of the "Women Who Inspire" series offered to her club members. After the success of this first trek to Station F, a second visit will be organized very soon, still with the same objective according to Tejal Pradhan: "to encourage women to launch themselves into entrepreneurship, by exchanging directly with those who have already taken this path". A New Academy to Listen to Biodiversity

Offered to L3 students in the Grande Ecole program, the Academies are a series of thematic seminars with alternating theoretical courses and practical workshops, which take place over two weeks in January. The themes, already numerous, were completed at the beginning of 2022 by the new Biodiversity Academy, which welcomed 14 students from various backgrounds. Designed by three alumni (Julie Christiaen H.21, Adam Melki H.20 and Eliette Verdier H.20), the program included visits to natural sites in the Ile-de-France region, field experiences, and discussions with scientists and business leaders. For François Collin (H.87), Director of Climate and Environmental Strategy at HEC, this new Academy is part of the school's overall commitment to teaching its students about major ecological challenges and making them aware of their future responsibilities: "The ability to anticipate the impact of a company in terms of biodiversity has become an absolutely essential skill for future managers and executives".
